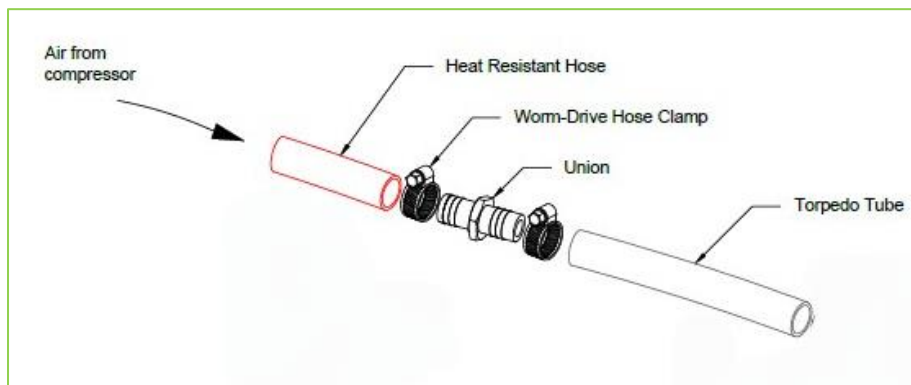


WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE BOX:

- 1 x Torpedo feeder line (option of 50 ft or 100 ft)
- 1 x Union
- 2 x Clamps

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

The following assembly instructions will help you make the connections between the heat resistant hose and the air supply hose. The function of the Torpedo tubing is to bring the air from the shore to the diffuser in the water. Torpedo is made to be in water, exposing this hose out of the water can affect its performance.



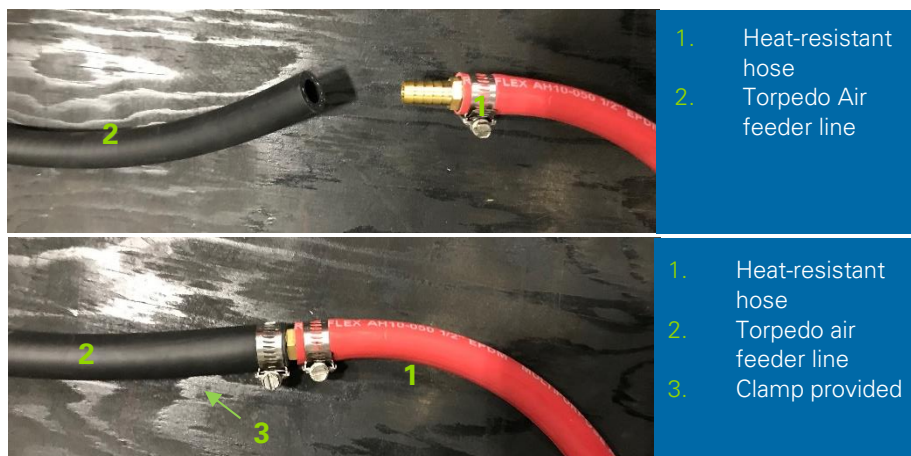
PREPARATION

Once the air compressor is in place, unroll the heat-resistant tubing coming out of the cabinet or compressor (usually a red or black tube) towards the shoreline.

TUBING CONNECTION

Insert a loosen clamp to 1 end of the Torpedo feeder line, insert the tubing over the barbed portion of the union already installed to the heat resistant hose and tighten the clamp around the Torpedo tubing using a flathead screwdriver. This union is already provided if your compressor / feeder comes from Canadian Pond.ca Products Ltd.

** The union included in the box allows you to connect Torpedo hose. If the Torpedo hose connects directly to the Bubble Tubing®, it is normal that after installation the union remains unused.*



Do not cut the excess of feeder lines except if you are installing a manifold.

MAINTENANCE

The Torpedo is designed to permanently stay at the bottom of water. Various conditions (biofilm, calcification, etc.) can reduce aeration performance with time (less bubbles visible at the surface). In this case, cleaning the tubing might be needed. For optimal performance, we recommend cleaning the tubing once or twice a year, based on water quality. BioPurge and EcoPurge are the only products tested and approved to clean the Torpedo.

Warning!

DO NOT USE CHLORINE, JAVEX, DRANO OR ANY OTHER CHEMICAL PRODUCT TO CLEAN THE TUBING.

WARNING!

- DO NOT USE A COMPRESSOR PROVIDING MORE THAN 50 PSI AS EXCESSIVE PRESSURE MAY DAMAGE THE BUBBLE TUBING®.
- DO NOT USE A SHOP COMPRESSOR NOT EQUIPPED WITH A PRESSURE REGULATOR. MAKE SURE PRESSURE DOES NOT EXCEED 50 PSI.

ANY OTHER WAY TO CLEAN THE AIRLINES WILL VOID THE WARRANTY OF THE BUBBLE TUBING®.

WARRANTY
